New benefits for EAEC Members

The European Association of ERASMUS Coordinators in its effort to enhance the membership to EAEC has recently developed the following benefits for its members. With the regular standard membership, which is currently provided to all 2017 members. New members who will become members in 2018 can join the benefits from 2017 by submitting their 2018 membership application form now. The benefits include:



- A. Reduced registration fees at the annual ERASMUS Congress and Exhibition, ERACON with free booth at the exhibition. From 2018 the exhibition will be two-fold, one day for networking and one day for student recruitment.
- B. Access to the new EU Funding Portal via the Daily Calendar of Calls.
- C. Weekly funding alerts to all academic and research personnel of its members.
- D. Access to the EAEC Partner Networking Portal for Funding, accessible by each researcher of the member institution/organization.
- E. Access to the EAEC Partner Networking Portal for Mobility Exchanges, accessible by each ERASMUS office and each academic department of HEIs.

Kick-off of the EAEC European Office in European Countries

On June 22nd 2017 the European Association of ERASMUS Coordinators (EAEC) launched its new funding information scheme and tool, networking portal and the

EAEC TASK Force Group, that aims to provide to the EAEC members a standard funding information support as part of the low cost annual membership fee. Additional options to network through the Thematic Innovation Meetings, consortia development support and preparation of proposals under the EAEC Task Force, supported by PROGNOSIS and coordinated by the EAEC European Coordination Office in Cyprus and in other countries.



During the presentation participants had the opportunity to see how the four pillars will be operating, and who are the EAEC Task Force members. As explained the new support is based on four pillars:

- (1) Information on Funding Calls, with access to a daily calendar and with weekly funding alerts,
- (2) Networking for Exchanges and Partner Search through a special designed portal with option to participate in Thematic Innovations Meetings/Contact Seminars,
- (3) Partner Search and Consortia Development and
- (4) Proposal Preparation Support.

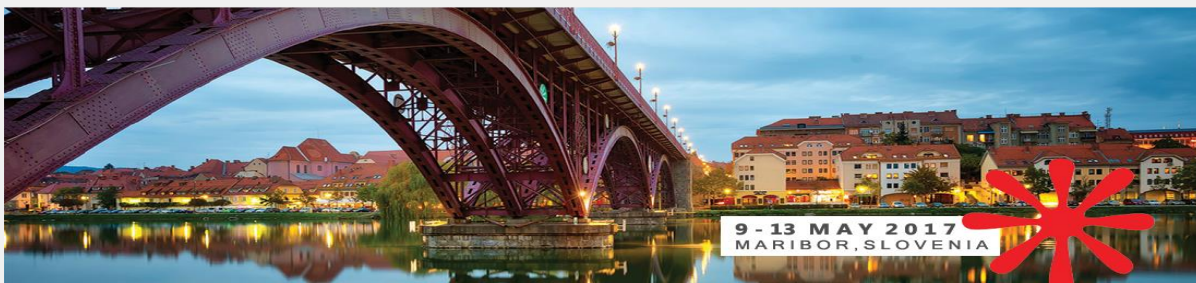
Programmes supported include among others the HORIZON2020, ERASMUS+ (KA 1,2,3).
