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MATHEU TRAINING COURSE (4 days course, could be extended to 5 days optionally)

Identification, Motivation and Support of Mathematical Talents in European Schools

The identification tool will be introduced and the educator will be trained on how to use it, in either primary or secondary education levels or adult education, but specifically for the ages 9-18. LE-MATH TRAINING COURSE (4 days course, could be extended to 5 days optionally)

Learning Mathematics through new communication factors

The new method of using mathematics communication activities for improving the teaching and learning of mathematics for pupils of age 9-18 or even for adult learning will be presented and elaborated. Trainees will also have hands on experience by playing roles of pupils and roles of teachers within the training programme. MATH-GAMES TRAINING COURSE (4 days course, could be extended to 5 days optionally)

Mathematics and Games : Maths and Numeracy Learning Methods based on games

This innovative teaching material is intended for all teachers who are active in the area of basic education (especially in the area of arithmetic learning). The focus is on the use of traditional games to teach individual topics of mathematical basic education with more motivation. Among other things, a specially developed Math-GAMES methodology and a short curriculum "Calculating learning in adult education" are presented with material that can also be used in Primary and lower secondary education classes. Counsellors having this experience will be able to promote the portal to the students in their HE institution and become a trainer for students and youth. The portfolio is semi-structured to the needs of university students and graduates and allows personal design development and creativity. STEAM (4 days course, could be extended optionally to 5 days)

Teaching STEM through Building Systems and Robotics

The course utilizing the ENGINO ROBOTICS & STEAM focuses on the latest trends in Pedagogy where the critical subjects of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics are approached interdisciplinary with hand's-on experiences. The patented ENGINO building system was developed by Engineers and Educators as a tool for creative building of technical models. The system includes besides structural components also gears, pulleys, solar panels, motors and robotic controllers. The course will help teachers understand better the concepts of STEAM and how robotics programming can be implemented in the classroom. Each session will involve the building of a model, the experimentation to understand the technology behind it and a presentation of the supporting theory. Most models will also be connected to the ENGINO ERP PRO controller and teachers will learn to program manually, with Simulator, with drag and drop icons and even with text language! Each day a different final challenge will be tackled by the participants from line following robots to automated houses and to chain reaction machines! The participants will receive a book with all the material presented and also a CD with interactive animations and worksheets to use with their students. BYOD (4 days course, could be extended optionally to 5 days)

Bring your own device: Active and Autonomous Learning Strategies with mobile devices

Developing an Entrepreneurial Mindset

DBOOT (5 days course)

Digital BootCamp

The digital skills are important for each of us. This course is designed to introduce participants to what can be accomplished using a computer. This is done by using popular software application programs such as web browser, word processor, spreadsheet, presentations, database or email program in a diverse and multinational environment. It is this environment that facilitates quick and deep learning in English language. Boot camp programs are an effective way to teach small groups to acquire skills in new technologies in a short period of time. During the bootcamp, participants will carry out typical tasks found in a real business setting. Peer learning will also be encouraged, along with the use of internet for finding relevant information, communicating and sharing information with others. The intent of this course is to introduce computer knowledge and skill sets that a participant can acquire and then apply these in a collaborative way using a computing device. Cost for training and accommodation

Training and Administration Fees: 80 euro per training day

Optional Accommodation, subject to availability:

Accommodation and related fees (F/B): 450 euro for 3 nights stay, 500 euro for 4 nights stay, 550 euro for 5 nights of stay or 600 for 6 nights of stay (all participants stay in the same hotel)

3 days course: includes 4 nights single room, 3 meals per day, coffee breaks, internet and social events

4 days course: includes 5 nights single room, 3 meals per day, coffee breaks, internet and social events

5 days course: includes 6 nights single room, 3 meals per day, coffee breaks, internet and social events

Course Location: Nicosia Capital or Protaras Beach Area or Larnaca Beach Area or Rodon Agros Mount Resort, depending on the month of the year that the course is offered. In Greece the location is Athens city or Piraeus city or Thessaloniki.
