Re: New opportunities for EAEC members

The European Association of ERASMUS Coordinators in its effort to improve the membership to EAEC has recently developed useful tool for its members. All of them will be communicated during the coming ERASMUS Congress and Exhibition – ERACON 2018 planned to be hosted by the University of Murcia, Span, during 8-12 May 2018.

With the regular standard membership, the following are included:

- 1. Reduced registration fees at the annual ERASMUS Congress and Exhibition, ERACON with free booth at the Exchange exhibition, University to University meetings(U2U) and at the recruitment fair organized during ERACON since 2018*
- 2. Access to the new EU Funding Portal via the 365 Daily Calendar of Calls. Can be accessed by every researcher of your institution.*
- 3. Weekly summary of funding alerts sent to member institutions and assign contact persons.*
- 4. Access to the EAEC Partner Networking Portal for Funding, accessible by each researcher of the member institution/organization with a password.*
- 5. Access to the EAEC Partner Networking Portal for Exchanges, accessible by each ERASMUS office and each academic department of HEIs.*
- 6. Reduced fees to special training courses organized by EAEC (<http://courses.eaecnet.com>)*
- 7. Access to international students and graduates internships (paid and unpaid) with discount certificates for students of EAEC members.*

Access to the networking portal requires a password. Current members can request access codes, one per email address with institution url address. Trial reviews for prospective new members is possible. Access codes can be requested from taskforce@eaecnet.com .

Optional supplementary networking support is provided at an additional fee to the regular membership. This supplementary support includes:
