Participants in ERACON 2022 will be invited to a Round Table where the questions for the Barometer will be presented and will have an opportunity to suggest changes and/or additional questions.

UAegean ERASMUS+ students are now able to issue their digital identity card and store it in their mobile phone

The University of the Aegean myID Card Service enables UAegean ERASMUS Students and Academic Staff to issue Digital Identity Verifiable Credentials (VCs), store them in their mobile phone and, later on, use them to prove their ERASMUS status both physically and online with no need for password and account management. The UAegean ERASMUS myID Card service has been co-financed by the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF) of the European Union (SEAL Project | Grant Agreement No INEA/CEF/ICT/A2018/1633170)

The European Association of Erasmus Coordinators is a partner in the New HEI project "DEELforHOST": Digital Employer Engagement and Learning for Hospitality and Tourism under Pandemic and Other Crisis Situations.

The project will develop and deliver a smart Platform, which will act as an electronic tool facilitating communication, cooperation & learning between employers and HEIs offering programmes in Hotel and Tourism (HT). The platform will facilitate a functional relationship proactively satisfying the needs of all parties concerned: Hotel and Tourism Industry, HEIs in HT, teachers, students/graduates).

The main objectives of the project:

- Digital transformation and enhancement of employers' engagement between Higher Education(HE) and Hotel and Tourism Industry(HTI)
- Improvement of the HE curricula to meet the needs of HTI, utilizing resources and tools sourcing form the industry
- Online access HTI enterprises for practical training or employment of part-time or full-time students/graduates
