The training activities of the “InSign” project took place in Hybrid form, in Nicosia, Cyprus, in November 22-26, 2021. The partners of the project presented its objectives and activities to the participants invited. In the group of the participants, were deaf people, who worked closely with the partner experts of the project, for the development of the Cypriot signs, which will be used for the interpretation to the corresponding international signs. During the activities some innovative ways and means of communication were used, through an Avatar. The five day event was completed successfully with the stakeholders and the deaf participants to be looking forward to the results.



The INSIGN is a three-year project funded by the EC and aims to promote the access of deaf students to education, mobility and global citizenship. It will establish an innovative infrastructure to promote the communication between deaf and non-deaf as well as among international deaf students using International Sign, probably the simplest sign language to learn.
