#### NEW PROJECTS FOR THE EAEC IN 2022

The European Association of Erasmus Coordinators (EAEC) is announcing its participation in the management of three funded Erasmus+ projects, KA2 Cooperation among organisations and institutions, under the Call 2021.

The three projects are:

1) The Green VET Online Campus – “VETCAMP”: The “VETCAMP” project will design and implement an innovative high-performing digital education ecosystem, which will capitalize and enhance VET resources for delivering quality online vocational learning experiences and make them accessible to learners around the EU. 2) “REVEALING” - REalisation of Virtual rEality LearnIng Environments (VRLEs): The Virtual Reality Learning Environments (VRLEs) are much more effective in bridging the gap among online and conventional learning, enabling students and instructors to control their avatars in 3D simulated classrooms or laboratories. They interact with the environment, communicate and collaborate with peers and engage on educational tasks providing and receiving real-time feedback. The project will use the VRChat platform to support the creation of HEI-tailored VRLEs.

3) Sign Language Dictionary of Technical Terms for Education – “TechWhiz”: The project will develop an online semi-automatic platform to create and search a glossary providing explanations of technical or scientific terms in Sign language. It addresses a concrete need faced by deaf students and teachers; the need to understand, and explain, unknown technical concepts to students who do not master spoken languages.

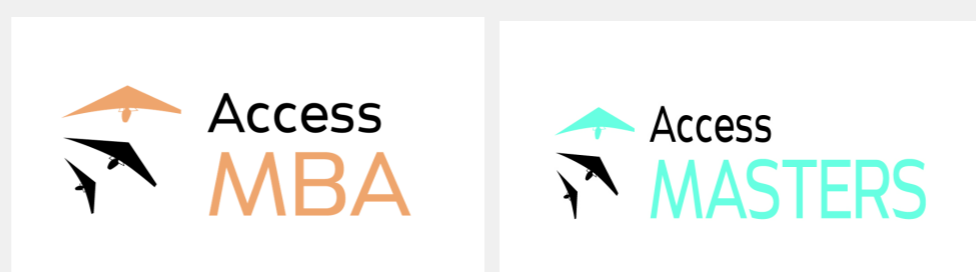
##### The parents’ Guidebook
