2nd Call for KA2 Partnerships in 2020

Following the communication earlier in August, entitled “Forthcoming 2nd Call for KA2 Partnerships in 2020” concerning KA2 Strategic Partnerships, we provide additional information as follows:

a. The two additional Calls will support Partnership projects that deal with the conditions caused by Covid-19 disease: "Strategic Partnerships in Response to the Covid-19 situation".

b. Exceptionally, the two Calls will support Partnerships concerning only the following themes and sectors:

- Digital education: School Education, Vocational Education and Training and Higher Education
- Creativity: School and Adult Education

c. Based on the themes set, Strategic Partnerships should address one of the following European Priorities:

- Innovative practices in a digital era
- Skills development and inclusion through creativity and the arts

d. Examples of activities to be carried out within the framework of the Digital Education Partnerships are as follows:

- Activities using digital tools and methods to provide quality and accessible education by online/virtual means
- Activities to support learners, teachers and trainers in order to adapt to the requirements of online/distance learning
- Activities to teach and promote safe and more responsible use of digital technology

e. Examples of activities to be carried out within the framework of the Partnerships for Creativity are:

- Activities aiming at enhancing every aspect of creativity in non-formal and formal education, through the development of relevant skills and competences
- Measures to speed up digital reform
- Activities to promote active citizenship and social inclusion through the arts, especially among young people

f. The duration of the Projects will be **between 12-24 months**

g. Applicants must submit their applications **by 29 October 2020 (12:00 – noon Brussels time)** for Projects **starting between 1 March and 30 June 2021**.
