WHO CAN APPLY?

- Traineeship is open to all EU citizens regardless of age
- A limited number of places are also allocated to non EU nationals

ELIGIBILITY:

The traineeship programme is open to University graduates who:

1. Have a University degree or equivalent, of at least 3 years of study, corresponding to a complete cycle (Bachelor)
2. Have a very good knowledge (C level as per the common EU framework of reference for languages) of two EU official languages, one of which must be a procedural language: English or French or German. For non EU nationals only one procedural language is required.
3. Have no prior work experience of any kind, in excess of 6 weeks in any EU institution, body or agency, EU delegations, with Members of Parliament (MEPs) or Advocates General at the EUCJ
