This way the formal approval of the big step that Serbia has taken this year: to join the Erasmus+ Programme as a programme country.

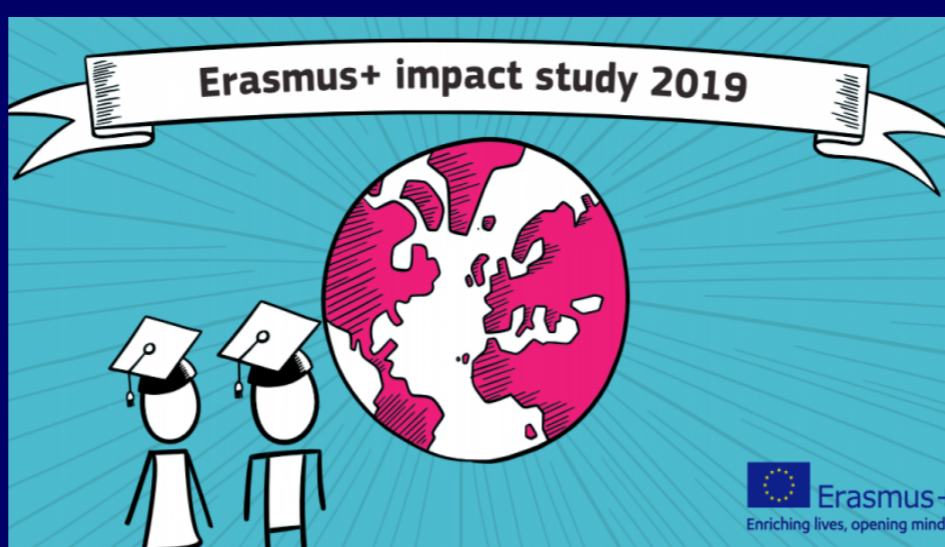

Commission adopts proposal for the next Erasmus Programme 2021-2027

On 30 May, the Commission adopted its proposal for the next Erasmus Programme, with a doubling of the budget to 30 billion euros for the period 2021-2027

Building on the success of Erasmus+, the next programme will provide learning and mobility opportunities to 12 million people, in comparison to 4 million people in the current programme. Its focus on "evolution, not revolution" means that the Erasmus programme will continue to cover schools, Vocational Education and Training, Higher Education and Adult Learning-Youth and Sport, but in a more streamlined manner.
