Winners of the 2018 "Altiero Spinelli Prize for outreach" celebrated in Brussels

The Altiero Spinelli Awards are a European Parliament initiative, implemented by the EC, awarded for the first time in 2017. The awards, aim at putting the spotligt on outstanding works that enhance citizens' understanding of the European Union and their motivation to participate in democratic process.

The above prizes are awarded for outstanding works that promote citizens' understanding of the EU. The 2018 " Altiero Spinelli Prize for outreach" specifically rewarded the following

types work:

- Innovative and practice-oriented educational programmes or campaigns and/or Massive Online Open courses
- Games (offline and/or online) with pedagogic purposes allowing young participants to experience Europe and its functioning in practice
- Collaborative projects and action based activities that promoted European common values, particularly via active participation of young people in the EU democratic process

Five prizes of Euro 25000 were awarded to works that aimed to enhance young peoples' understanding of the EU, with focus on participation in EU democratic process.
